- Campers requiring any form of assistance must be accompanied by an attendant.

Staff and Volunteers

Sea to Sky Aphasia Camp will be led by Howe Sound Rehabilitation Services Society staff and complemented with trained UBC student volunteers, members of the North Shore Stroke Recovery Branch and community volunteers.

Location:

Easter Seal Camp in Squamish BC at 41015 Government Rd. 45 miles North of Vancouver BC.

Accommodations:

Each room accommodates up to six people. Accessible bathrooms are centrally located in the main lodge.

\$150.00 per person. Includes all activities, meals and overnight accommodations for three days and two nights.
